

Transports

There are many ways to travel to Marburg. We have outlined some of the most common ways below.

▪ Travelling by air

Many Marburg travelers choose the Frankfurt am Main Airport (IATA: FRA). This is the major airport in the region and offers daily flights from many European cities. Travelers from there, take the following route:

Arrival Terminal 1 (FRA):

- Follow the signs to the „Regionalbahnhof“ (regional trains)
- Take any S-Bahn train to Frankfurt „Hauptbahnhof“ (central station) (ca. 10 minutes)
- Take any train to Marburg (ca. 70 minutes)

Arrival Terminal 2 (FRA):

Take the direct shuttle bus to the airport train stations (the stop is located just outside the terminal exit on level 2). During hours when the shuttle bus is not operating, follow the signs to „Bahnhöfe (train stations) via Sky Line“.

- Take any S-Bahn train to Frankfurt central station (ca. 10 minutes)
- Take any train to Marburg (ca. 70 minutes)

Another option to travel by plane, is the Frankfurt-Hahn Airport (IATA: HHN). This airport is the major German hub of low-cost carrier Ryanair. Despite the name, this airport is 120 kilometers away from Frankfurt am Main. Train services to/from Hahn are not available, but an airport bus service operates several times per day between Frankfurt-Hahn Airport (HHN) and Frankfurt am Main Hauptbahnhof (central station). Car rental and taxis are also available at Frankfurt-Hahn Airport.

▪ Travelling by train

Marburg has two train stations and can be reached by train very comfortably. Travelers to the city center should exit the train at „Hauptbahnhof“ Marburg (Lahn). From the main station to the city center, a taxi will cost about 6 EUR. The current train timetables can be found at Deutsche Bahn's website: <http://www.bahn.de/>



Old town of Marburg

The old town of Marburg is a pedestrian zone. This area is closed for cars and can only be used by public city buses and taxis.

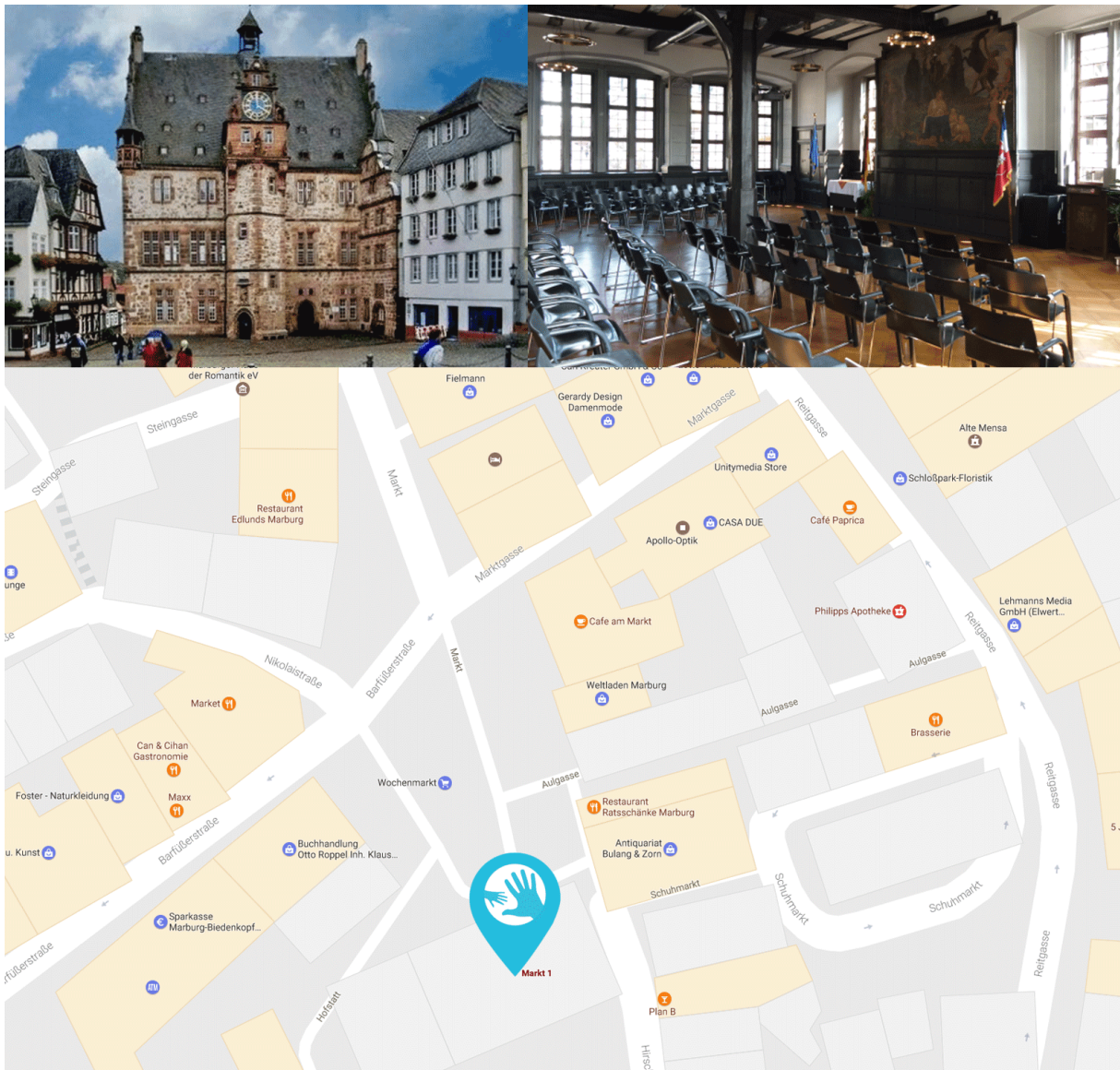
